

Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1st semester of the 2022/2023 academic year

Department: Genetics, Cell- and Immunobiology

Faculty: ED Basic Immunology FOKOGEN347_1A

Our feedback on general comments by the students: The feedback results for Basic Immunology subject are significantly slightly lower than the faculty average. Number of students, who filled the OMHV evaluations prior to registration for the exams is 43.

Lectures:

Number of students attending the lectures were the next:

2022.09.13: 13 persons

2022.09.20: 3 persons

2022.09.27: 4 persons

2022.10.04: 5 persons

2022. 10.11: 4 persons

2022. 10.18: 4 persons

2022.10.25: 3 persons

2022.11.29: 2 persons

Taken together, as approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ of students haven't attended the lectures, the result of the survey hardly reflects the real situation.

Actually the **average of on the spot (realtime** after the lecture) evaluations of the lectures (**K04, K05**), were the next: **4.83** (4.42; 4.67; 4.75; 4.80; 5.00; 5.00; 5.00; 5.00 of 8 lectures) **compared to the result (4.09) of the general OMHV survey.**

In the next we would like to increase the interest of students for the subject by holding mini-tests at the end of the lectures for bonus points. Students achieving an appropriate threshold by collecting bonus points, are offered to take a simplified exam.

Practices:

For **K03, K06, K08, K09** the replies reflect for the next problem: Unfortunately, it makes very difficult to hold 45-minute practices if the number of students exceeds the desired 15 people per group. Anyhow, the answers in **K05** reflected to the dedication and helpfulness of the teachers.

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

- *„Please upload lecture recordings”*. We follow the instructions of the Rector and the Dean and we hold the lectures with personal attendance. In the last year all lectures were available in a voice completed version, animations follow the speed of live lecture voice. This year we tried to force students to be in person at the lectures by not providing the recorded version. However students, taking place in lectures were informed about the voice completed version of the previous year. We are going to continue the recordings of the lectures in the future, as we have experienced this helps a lot to study properly. Moreover we provided online zoom consultations on each weeks of the exam period. We provided 180 very basic pop-in questions with correct answers to help study the principles of immunology. At the exam 15 of 60 points included these pre-provided tests and 30 out of 60 points had to be obtained for a successful exam.
- *„Practical classes were useless. No labs just a review of the lectures which are pointless to have”* Answer: Indeed, the practices are not manual, more seminars. The topics of it are based on recent laboratory, diagnostic and therapeutic practice, and are clearly different from theoretical topics of the lectures. Obviously, the knowledge of the theoretical background is necessary to understand the practical issues.
