

Compulsory Safety Regulations for Students

Because of the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic situation, we ask our students to follow the regulations described below (in addition to the general safety rules to prevent accidents that are introduced on the first practices/seminars:

- Practices/seminars and lectures can be attended only by healthy students with no symptoms of coronavirus infection or any other infectious disease.
- In the laboratories (L13-L16) it is compulsory for everyone to wear a mask or scarf that covers both the nose and the mouth. Violation of this rule excludes a student from the practice/seminar or lecture and will have legal consequences according to the directive of the Rector and Chancellor (E/19/2020. (VIII. 28.).
- When entering the laboratory (L13-L16), it is compulsory to rinse your hand at a contact-free disinfectant dispenser.
- When waiting in front of the laboratories, you must keep 1.5 m distance from other students.
- Lecture hall can accommodate students to 1/3 of their total capacity. In the lecture halls available seats will be marked clearly in advance, in order to keep the 1.5-2 m distance between students.
- Mask and social distancing are compulsory during and when in person lectures.

Exclusion of a student from a practice/seminar means „absence” automatically.
